We know how important food is for children and young people, especially when they are away from home. We always offer a good variety of food for each meal.

- For breakfast, there is a continental breakfast every day, including a cooked item or cold meat and cheese, and a hot breakfast at least once a week.

THE LANGUAGE COURSE

- Tuition will focus on spoken communication and will be based on a syllabus especially designed for those with an interest in soccer.
