



# **QUARANTINE PROGRAMME OVERVIEW**

Stafford House are pleased to introduce our quarantine programme at Dover College and Stafford House Canterbury this summer. The programme has been specially designed for groups travelling to the UK from "amber" countries this summer. Our aim is simple, to ensure students have a fun and productive quarantine experience in a safe environment while following UK government guidelines. Students will complete the required quarantine period for the first 5 days of their course at Dover College, this will be followed by a test to release on day 5. Once negative test results have been received students will then be able to move to Stafford House Canterbury and take part in our usual programme ensuring the required guidelines are followed.





# COUNTRY

Groups arriving must produce the following negative Covid Tests

Once a group arrives at school it will form a "school bubble". Within this bubble students will be able to take part in face- to-face lessons as well as a full programme of engaging fully supervised activities, all on the school campus. All meals will be delivered to groups at their boarding house and students will be required to stay on the school campus at all times. # **GROUP QUARANTINE PROGRAMME CONDITIONS:**

- Quarantine is legally enforceable in the UK and violation of quarantine regulations carries a first offence fine of £1,000 and up to £10,000 fines for repeat offences. It is vital that all students, group leaders and staff follow all Stafford House guidance during quarantine to ensure we do not break the law.

- A bubble is made of all students and group leaders arriving on campus on the same day. The bubble will have specific staff for lessons and activities who will join them in their bubble. Management and centre operations staff will be outside the bubble and only interact with students, staff and group leaders in the bubble in a covid-safe manner, observing social distancing and other covid safe measures as per our COVID protocol.

- A bubble may consist of just one group (depending on the size of the group). It must be asked at the time of booking whether the group is willing to enter a bubble with another group arriving on the same day. Spaces are limited, and a willingness to enter a bubble with other groups may allow SH to have greater flexibility to accept the group on the guarantine programme. Where more than one group is in a bubble together, these groups will be kept isolated from each other until the day 2 test result is clear. These groups will have online lessons and activities for the first 2 days.





- The SH Group quarantine programme requires groups to sign up for the "Test to Release" test on the 5th day. Upon successful negative result from Test to Release groups will be transferred to SH Canterbury. Test to release on day 5 results may take up to 48 hours to arrive. Test to release is in addition to the day 2 and day 8 tests that are mandatory for all arrivals into the UK.

- All staff and students will have a minimum of 2 Lateral Flow tests conducted at the centre each week.

- If any student, group leader or staff member in a bubble tests positive the following measures must take place: a. If the person tests positive on a Lateral Flow Test, a PCR test will be requested from the NHS and be taken within 24 hours.

b. Any person who tests positive will be isolated from the bubble in a private room (either their room or the school's sick bay dependent on circumstances) and not able to join in interactive activities while isolating for 10 days unless the PCR tests is negative. Some online lessons and activities will be provided for any students who are isolating.

c. The bubble of a person testing positive will be required to quarantine for a further 10 days and daily lateral flow testing for all. Everyone in the bubble is legally required to remain in the same location and cannot travel.

It is vital that all groups have insurance that covers this possibility (including students who do not test positive themselves). Insurance cover is the responsibility of the partner

d. SH will endeavour to deliver all aspects of the programme that are possible in any time remaining after quarantine is completed. SH will not be liable for any missed excursions or activities due to a positive COVID test result not allowing sufficient time.

agency.

- All groups should come with at least two group leaders to allow for sufficient care and supervision in the event of a positive case within the group or of a group leader.

- All students will need to travel with a tablet or laptop computer to allow for classes and activities to be followed online in the event of a positive case.

- Any groups who, through contact with positive cases, are required to extend their stay in quarantine will be charged by SH at a pro-rated amount of their course fees for any additional days on the quarantine programme.





# THE SCHOOL:

Dover College is an independent day and boarding school in Dover in southeast England . The school occupies some of the medieval buildings of Dover Prioy. The College provides the perfect setting for a learning adventure. Set around a central green with stunning views of the Castle and the English Channel the school boasts excellent facilities. There is an indoor sports hall, extensive green, cricket and volleyball nets as well as a dance studio that students can enjoy. All accommodation is onsite.

# **PUBLIC TRANSPORT INFORMATION:** DOVER

### Nearest airport: Gatwick 125km, Stansted 161 km, Heathrow 160 km

- Nearest rail station: Dover Priory 160m (3 min walk)
- High Speed train to London only takes 1 hour 5 mins
- 10-minute walk from school to city centre











### Medical Facilities

The school is situated centrally and has medical facilities located nearby. Stafford House staff will be able to assist students that require an appointment\*. \*At cost

### Doctors on Call

We will also have GMC registered doctors in the UK on call (at a supplementary cost) to provide telephone/ video consultations should the need arise. They will be able to provide a thorough diagnosis and prescribe any medication required.

### **Temperature Checks**

Regular temperature checks of students and staff will be taken using non-contact infra-red thermometers. These are quick and simple and can be carried out at a distance.

### Medical Room

If a student does begin to feel unwell during the school day a medical room will be available for them to isolate, relax and recuperate in a restful environment

# WHAT'S INCLUDED:



Students will take part in 15 hours of English language lessons per week. Lessons are topic based and designed to be fun, energetic and informative. They enable students to use their English in real world situations and increase their confidence.

### **EXCURSIONS**

Once the quarantine period has been satisfactorily completed students will take part in our excursion programme. Full and half day excursions allow students to really get to know the UK. We use major destinations such as London, Brighton and Cambridge as a classroom where students will find historic and cultural information through guided walking tours and visits to museums and other places of interest.



### CERTIFICATE

Each student will have their English level tested upon arrival and will be placed in a class accordingly. Students will receive a portfolio to store their work in as well as a certificate to take home with them as a record of their course with us.
