WHAT'S INCLUDED:



Students will take part in 15

hours of English language lessons per week. Lessons are topic based and designed to be fun, energetic and informative. They enable students to use their English in real world situations and increase their confidence.



ART

Students will take part in 9 hours per week of Art. These sessions will be taught by specialist teachers and will enable those who take part to really develop skills and confidence in their particular area of interest.



ACTIVITIES

We offer a variety of onsite activities including sports, arts and crafts and team games. The school day will finish with an evening activity which will include discos, international nights and talent shows. Our activities provide opportunities for students to use the English they have learnt and make international friends.



EXCURSIONS

Full and half day excursions allow students to really get to know the UK. We use major destinations such as London, Cambridge and Edinburgh as a classroom where students will find historic and cultural information through guided walking tours and visits to museums and other places of interest.

COURSE STRUCTURE

This specialised course aims to provide students with a broad knowledge of a number of artistic disciplines. Students will explore a range of wet and dry techniques in 2 and 3 dimensions, as well as using multi-media. Students will develop their skills and understanding through access to a wide variety of media, demonstrations, and creative experiences.

Students will learn to recognise the work of selected artists and use their art as inspiration for their own work.

Students will have the opportunity to explore and develop their own ideas as well as to follow guidance.

Every student will learn to use a working sketchbook, create a portfolio, and present selected pieces of art to other students and to invited guests, in a gallery context.

Students will develop their comprehension and use of English in a creative working environment.
