

WHAT'S INCLUDED:



TUITION

Students will take part in 17.5 hours of lessons per week. Lessons are topic based and designed to be fun, energetic and informative. They enable students to use their English in real world situations and increase their confidence.



ACTIVITIES

We offer a variety of onsite activities including sports, arts and crafts and team games. Our activities provide opportunities for students to use the English they have learnt and make international friends.



EXCURSIONS

Full and half day excursions allow students to really get to know London. With 4 half day excursions a week around London as well as a full day excursion, students will find historic and cultural information through guided walking tours and visits to museums and other places of interest. One local business visit and one local professional speaker per 2 week program.



CERTIFICATE

Each student will have their English level tested upon arrival and will be placed in a class accordingly. Students will receive a portfolio to store their work in as well as a certificate to take home with them as a record of their course with us.

The Young Business Leaders is a demanding programme, using case studies to focus on entrepreneurship, leadership and effective professional communication. Featuring coaching on presentation skills and effective teamwork, students work towards a final presentation pitch in the final lesson in each 2 week course. The course takes place at Guildhouse School, which is located on Bloomsbury Square in London.

Half-day activities are tied in to learning objectives enabling learning outside the classroom to combine with exploring the great city of London. Evening activities and weekend excursions are pure fun and excitement.

Guildhouse School London is a modern, well-equipped boarding school located in the heart of Central London in the district of Bloomsbury. The school boasts some fantastic teaching facilities, whilst being within easy reach of all of the exciting attractions London has to offer. Residential accommodation is in a refurbished, modern, townhouse with single and twin room bedrooms with ensuite bathrooms. There are common rooms, study facilities and WiFi throughout.

Through a mix of case studies, and applied business theory, our students develop skills that will empower them to be future leaders. The course develops leadership and communication skills with a focus on innovation, entrepreneurship and resilience.
