IGCSE exams are recognised globally and provide a stepping stone to further education. This course is designed for groups who are keen to improve their IGCSE subject knowledge and develop strategies for exam success. Students participate in interactive lessons and mock exams to motivate and move them towards exam success.

COURSE OVERVIEW

Our English Plus Activities with IGCSE combines English lessons and exam preparation with project work, cultural excursions and local visits. Groups choose one topic from a range of IGCSE subjects including Maths, Science, Geography, Languages and Business Studies*. Participants will take part in interactive classes involving group activities, games and multi-media resources to keep students motivated and engaged. There will also be a focus on essential vocabulary and grammar required. Exam strategies, practice tests and feedback will also be an essential part of the course. The group's programmes can be designed to include both IGCSE and English Language components depending on needs.

While our standard programme includes 15 hours of lessons, we can be flexible and accommodate additional IGCSE lessons or General English to replace scheduled afternoon activities and visits- this can be discussed with our reservations department and will incur additional costs.



ACTIVITIES & EXCURSIONS

Student will take part in a programme of project work, local visits and excursions depending on the chosen location. Excursions allow students to really get to know the UK. We use major destinations such as London, Oxford, Cambridge and Brighton as a classroom where students will find historic and cultural information through guided walking tours and visits to museums and other places of interest.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

The IGCSE Programme is a supplementary course that runs across all four of our Year Round Centres. It is available to groups of 10 or more at our Cambridge, London and Canterbury centres and groups of 30 or more at our Bracknell centre.

Accommodation: Students who join us at Stafford House Canterbury will have the choice of home stay or residential accommodation. At our London and Cambridge centres we offer home stays only, where students will stay with a local host family during their visit.
