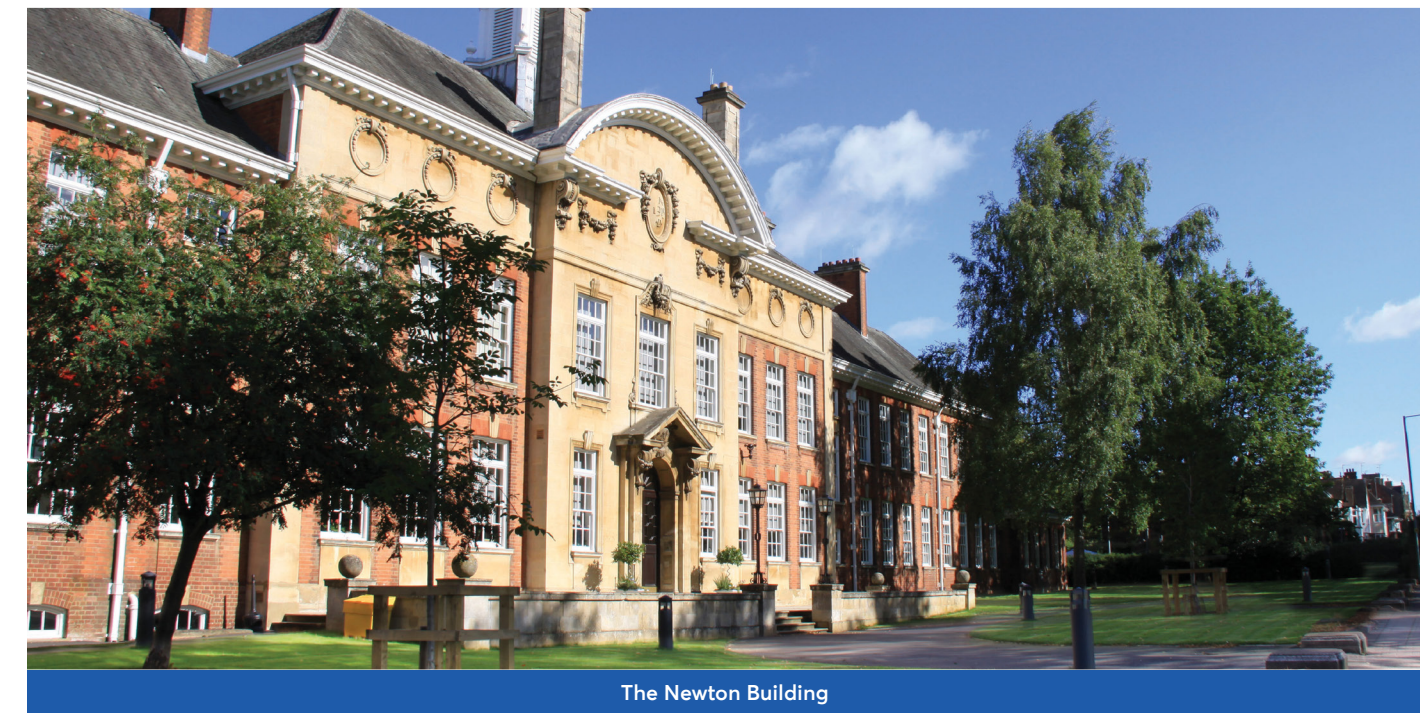

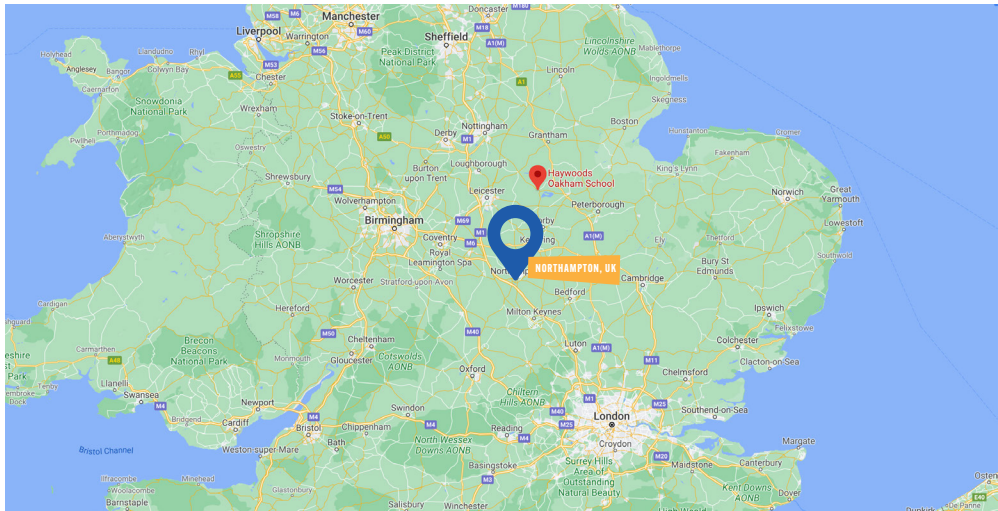

TUITION

Students studying IELTS or STEM will take part in 22.5 hours of lessons per week. Those on the classic course will take part in 15 hours of lessons. Lessons are topic based and designed to be fun, energetic and informative. They enable students to use their English in real world situations and increase their confidence.



ACTIVITIES

We offer a variety of activities including sports, arts and crafts and workshops. Our activities provide opportunities for students to use the English they have learnt in the classroom with their friends.



EXCURSIONS

Full and half day excursions, as well as local visits allow students to really get to know the UK. One full-day excursion per week is included. Destinations may include London, Cambridge or Oxford. Two half-day excursions per week are included, destinations may include Warwick Castle, Bletchley Park, Bicester Village or Stratford-Upon-Avon.



CERTIFICATE

Each student will have their English level tested upon arrival and will be placed in a class accordingly. Students will receive a portfolio to store their work in as well as a certificate to take home with them as a record of their course with us.



EXCURSIONS

One full-day excursion per week is included. Destinations may include London, Cambridge or Oxford. Two half-day excursions per week are included, destinations may include Warwick Castle, Oxford, Bicester Village or Stratford-Upon-Avon.



ACCOMMODATION

Residential accommodation is onsite in one of six boarding houses. All houses have an outside area, laundry facilities, a shared kitchen and common room. There are a variety of single and shared rooms in all residences, with shared bathrooms.
