



Students on this course will participate in an exciting range of activities based mainly in and around Rutland Water, a reservoir and nature reserve near to the school. Activities may include various types of watersports, horse riding, climbing, building rafts and emergency shelters, orienteering, and a guided cycle ride around Rutland Water.

TENNIS

AGE: 12-17 (individuals)

DURATION: 1-4 weeks

LOCATION: Woodcote

COACHING: 9 hours per week

ENGLISH LEVEL: Elementary to Advanced

ABILITY LEVEL: Beginner to Advanced

Students will enjoy 9 hours per week of professional tennis coaching. The sessions will include technical development for all shots used in the game including groundstrokes, serve, return of serve and net play, together with an emphasis on the tactics and strategies required in match play, including court positioning for both singles and doubles matches.

BASKETBALL

AGE: 14-17 (individuals)

DURATION: 1-4 weeks

LOCATION: Canterbury

ABILITY LEVEL: Beginner to Advanced

We will provide students with 9 hours per week of basketball coaching by accredited coaches. The training will focus on all the skills and techniques used in the game, including dribbling, shooting, passing, court awareness and teamwork. Students are encouraged to practise and demonstrate what they have learnt, through competitive exercises, culminating in an exciting tournament each week.

Students will be taught how to groom horses, how to keep a horse and its stable clean, and how to use and handle riding equipment, as well as enjoying indoor and outdoor riding sessions with qualified instructors within the safe environment of the riding centre.





WHAT'S ON THE MENU?



We know how important food is for children and young people, especially when they are away from home. We always offer a good variety of food for each meal.

- For breakfast, there is a continental breakfast every day, including a cooked item or cold meat and cheese, and a hot breakfast at least once a week.
- For lunch and dinner, we provide hot meals with a choice of main courses, including a vegetarian option. We also ensure there is always a salad bar including cold protein items such as ham, egg or cheese.
- There is also fresh fruit and yoghurt available every day. For full day excursions we provide a generous packed meal.
- We are able to cater for different diets providing we have prior warning at the time of booking, such as coeliac, vegetarian, nut allergy and halal.
- All students are given something to eat when they arrive, no matter what the time is.

Student safety has always been a priority at Stafford House and we understand that it will be even more important in summer 2021.

WE CARE

To make our school communities as safe as possible we have made our WeCare pledge, this will ensure that our students can enjoy their experience with us while being confident that they are in the safest possible environment.

We have put a number of practical procedures in place.

We will of course be working with government guidelines to ensure the highest possible standards.

ONSITE NURSES*

Each of our residential centres in summer 2021 will have a nurse available onsite during the school day to assist students who are feeling unwell.

DOCTORS ON CALL

We will also have GMC registered doctors in the UK on call



(at a supplementary cost) to provide telephone/video consultations should the need arise. They will be able to provide a thorough diagnosis and prescribe any medication required.

MEDICAL ROOM

If a student does begin to feel unwell during the school day a medical room will be available for them to isolate, relax and recuperate in a restful environment.

All residential centres (excluding Yale, New Haven) in the UK, US and Canada have onsite medical

provision. Yale has medical facilities nearby.

SCHOOL LIFE

THOROUGH AND INFORMATIVE STUDENT INDUCTIONS

We want to make sure that each and every student that stays with us feels safe and secure in the school environment. Students will receive a warm welcome and thorough induction including information on how to stay safe during their stay.

HANDWASHING

To ensure good hygiene standards are maintained at our centres, we will make time for students to wash their hands between lessons and activities and before mealtimes. This will be monitored closely by our welfare team with extra supervision in place for our younger students.

HAND SANITISER

As our students are often on the go, 70 % + alcohol hand sanitiser will be available throughout our centres and on excursions. Students will be shown where they can find it at induction and encouraged to use it frequently.

ENHANCED CLEANING

All rooms are deep cleaned before occupation and hard surfaces are frequently cleaned with sanitising cleaning liquids that guarantees to kill 99.99% of germs and bacteria including Covid 19.

ACCOMMODATION ARRANGEMENTS

Our group students will only share a room with other students from their group.



STUDENT WELFARE OFFICERS

Our friendly, professional and well-trained teams of Student Welfare Officers are onsite to ensure that our students are supported in all aspects of school life. They will be on hand to provide help with our new school hygiene procedures and will be able to assist if a student requires a visit to the nurse or doctor's appointment.




