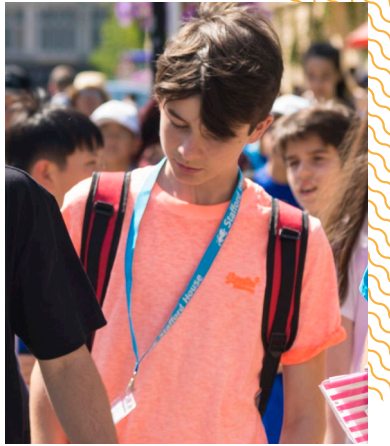

SUMMARY

We understand that it is important for students to receive an internationally recognised qualification. We therefore offer Trinity College London's Graded Examinations in Spoken English (GESE) at all our centres.

The exams are suitable for candidates who have learnt English as a foreign, second or additional language. They are one-to-one oral exams that test candidates' abilities in listening and speaking.

The GESE examinations are well suited to summer schools and short courses because everyone can be successful at their own level and can go home with an internationally recognised certificate and a feeling of accomplishment.

PREPERATION

- The table below can be used to determine the Trinity grade at which each student should be entered
- The Stafford House placement test is linked to the Trinity grading system and we will be happy to assist you with the grade choice for your students
- Our Classic Course syllabus, with its focus on speaking and listening, will help students to prepare for the exam
- We also provide two extra lessons for candidates prior to the exam. These sessions will explain exactly what students will be expected to do during the exam and will ensure that they are well-prepared

WHY TAKE TRINITY EXAMS AT STAFFORD HOUSE?

- There are 12 levels to choose from, meaning students can be entered at the correct level for their ability and be confident of passing
- Students are able to choose their own topics for discussion, providing an opportunity for relevant and motivating conversations
- Examiners put students at ease and give them opportunities to demonstrate their ability to communicate in English
- Instant results are provided at the end of the exam, along with a report on each student

BOOKING NOTES

We are only able to enter students for the exam if the student's required level, date of birth and full (correctly spelt) name are all provided at the time of booking.

In case of lost certificates or errors in students' details, duplicate certificates are available at a cost of £50.00 per certificate.

FEES

- Grades 1-12: £75 per entrant
- Price includes examination registration, two exam preparation lessons and certificate
- The minimum number of students required for an exam session is normally 15, depending on the level of the exam

CANCELLATION CHARGES

Cancellations prior to 31st May 2020 will not incur any charges.

Cancellations on or after 31st May 2020 will be non-refundable.

No cancellation charge will apply if you wish to substitute one student for another.
