2. LESSONS

Projects are usually completed in small groups and can be presented in a variety of ways including online posters, blogs, short films, and magazine or newspaper articles.



4. ACTIVITIES

Activities Include: blog writing, international events, test yourself challenges, talent shows and scavenger hunts.

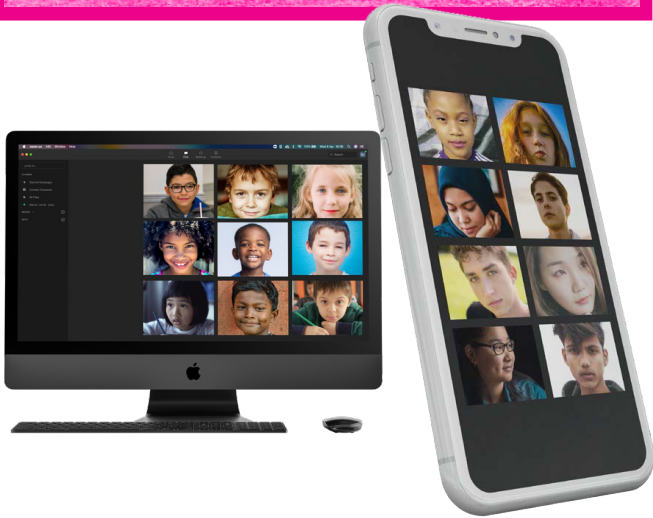
6. HOMEWORK
