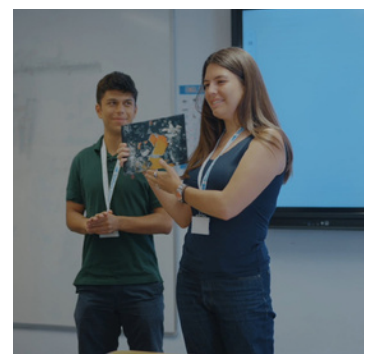
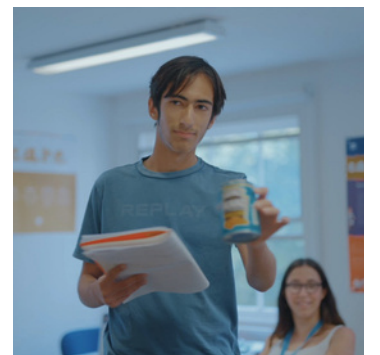
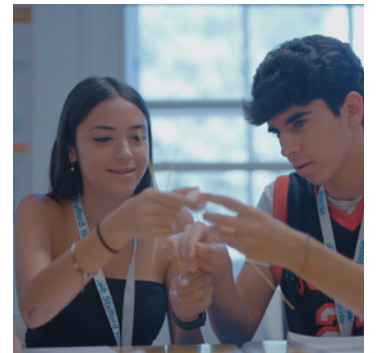


YOUNG BUSINESS LEADERS

TUITION

Students will take part in 22.5 hours of lectures, workshops and case study based lessons that focus on areas such as building a team, conflict resolution and leadership styles. There will also be opportunities to develop presentation and public speaking skills.



ACTIVITIES

In class activities develop business knowledge and skills. Evening activities are fun and engaging, offering opportunities for students to use their English in social contexts and make international friends.



EXCURSIONS

The Young Business Leaders is a demanding program, using case studies to focus on entrepreneurship, leadership and effective professional communication. Featuring coaching on presentation skills and effective teamwork, students work towards a final presentation pitch in the final lesson in each 2 week course.

The course is held at Brunel University London, which occupies a modern and spacious campus, 15 minutes’ walk from the lively town of Uxbridge.

As well as a range of on-campus amenities, students benefit from their proximity to Central London, with all the major attractions being accessible.

Through a mix of case studies, and applied business theory, our students develop skills that will empower them to be future leaders. The course develops leadership and communication skills with a focus on innovation, entrepreneurship and resilience.
