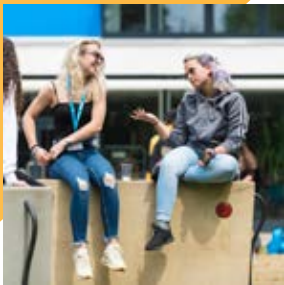

GETTING TO STAFFORD HOUSE SUMMER CAMBRIDGE



Stansted airport is 30mins away from Cambridge by road or public transport. From Stansted airport you can catch a train direct to Cambridge, which take about 30mins. From other airports you can easily take transport to Cambridge.



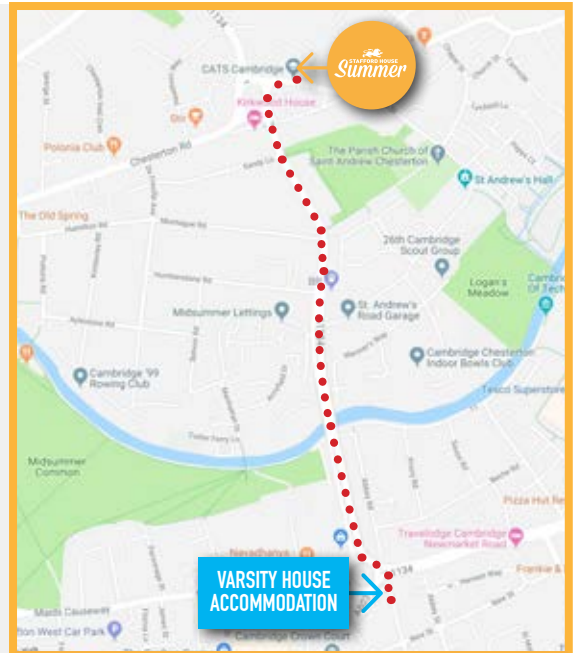
There is a direct train service from London Kings Cross to Cambridge every half an hour, journey time is approx. 1 hour. From Cambridge station a taxi can take you to CATS College in just 10mins, or turn right and walk to Gwydir Street (8mins walk) where the no.2 bus will take you to CATS College (15mins)



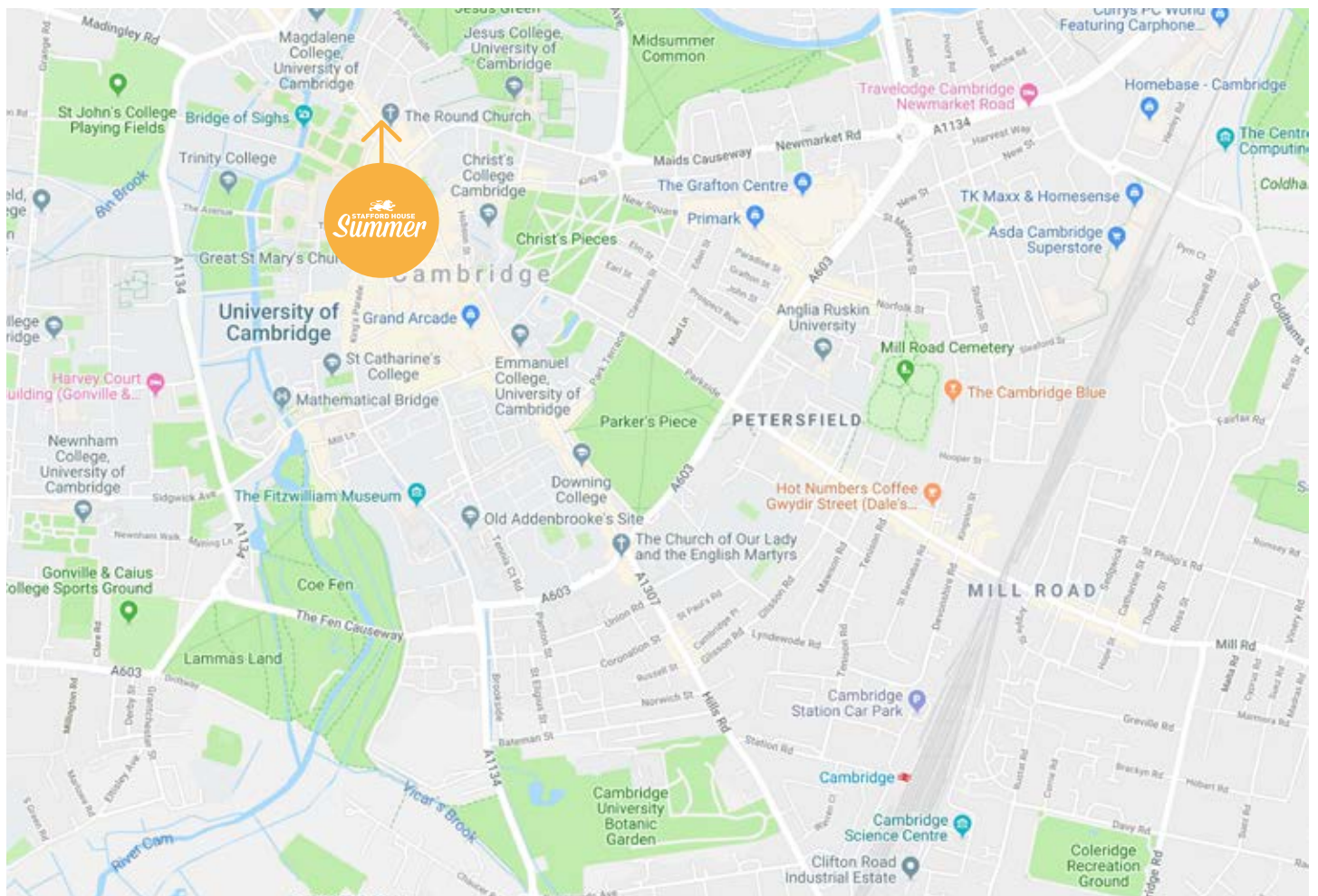
National Express Coaches run from Stansted Airport to Cambridge bus station (50mins) and from London Victoria bus station to Cambridge (around 2.5hours). Cambridge bus station is a 20 min walk from CATS College.



From London, exit the M11 at Junction 13 and turn right into Madingley Road. Continue on Madingley Road turn left at the mini-roundabout - Northampton Street. At the traffic lights, go straight across to Chesterton Road. Approach the next junction in the righthand lane and follow the one-way system, keeping to the right, around the large traffic island marked by central buildings and Lloyds Bank. Take the exit marked Chesterton and onto Chesterton Road towards Elizabeth Way/A1134. At the Chesterton roundabout take the second exit for Chesterton and the Campus is located on your left hand side.

GETTING TO VARSITY HOUSE ACCOMMODATION



Stansted airport is 30 minutes away from Cambridge by road or public transport. From Stansted airport you can catch the train direct to Cambridge, which takes 30 minutes.



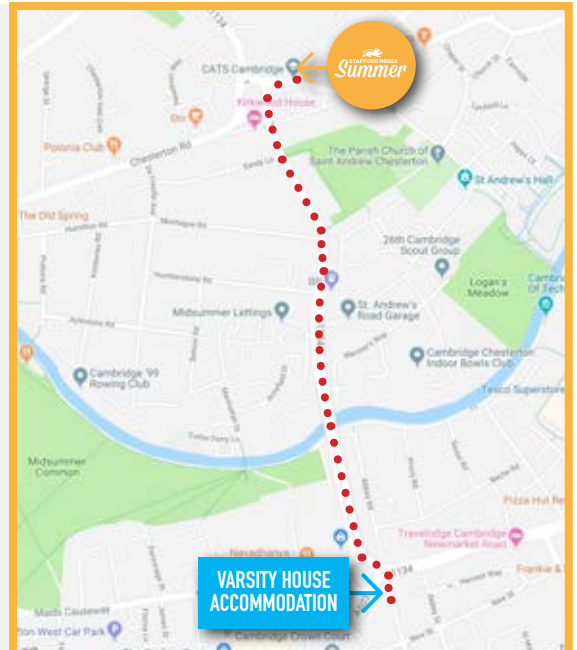
There is a direct train service from London Kings Cross to Cambridge every half an hour; journey time is approx. 1 hour. The train station is 20 minutes' walk from Varsity House, or you can get the number 3 bus from outside the train station, which stops across the road from Varsity House.



National Express coaches run frequently from Stansted Airport to Parker's Piece in Cambridge (50 minutes). The bus stop is just a 10-minute walk from Varsity House.



From London, exit the M11 at Junction 11. Follow the A1309 onto Trumpington Road and turn right onto the A603 (Lensfield Road). Follow this road until you reach the traffic lights opposite the Grafton Centre, and turn right onto St. Matthew's Street then immediately left onto New Street. The Varsity House reception is on your left just before the mini roundabout.
