GETTING TO STAFFORD HOUSE CHICHESTER



Southampton Airport is the closest airport - only 45 mins away by car, Gatwick Airport has flights to all international destinations and it is approximately 1hr 15mins by road or 1hr by rail. Heathrow is 1hr 45mins by road.



From Chichester train station it is a 5min walk to the centre. Trains run regularly from London to Chichester and the journey takes 1hr 30mins.



National Express provides a coach service from London Victoria coach station to Chichester. The journey takes approxmately 1hr 40mins. There are also several coaches from Brighton to Chichester (1hr 10mins) and Portsmouth to Chichetser (40mins)



Chichester College is situated just off the A27. At the Fishbourne roundabout take the 1st exit onto Cathedral Way/A259, stay on A259 then turn left onto Swieqi Road.
