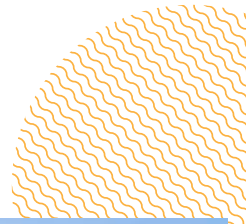

Gatwick and Stansted airports are 1.5 hours by road. Heathrow airport is 1.45 hours by road.



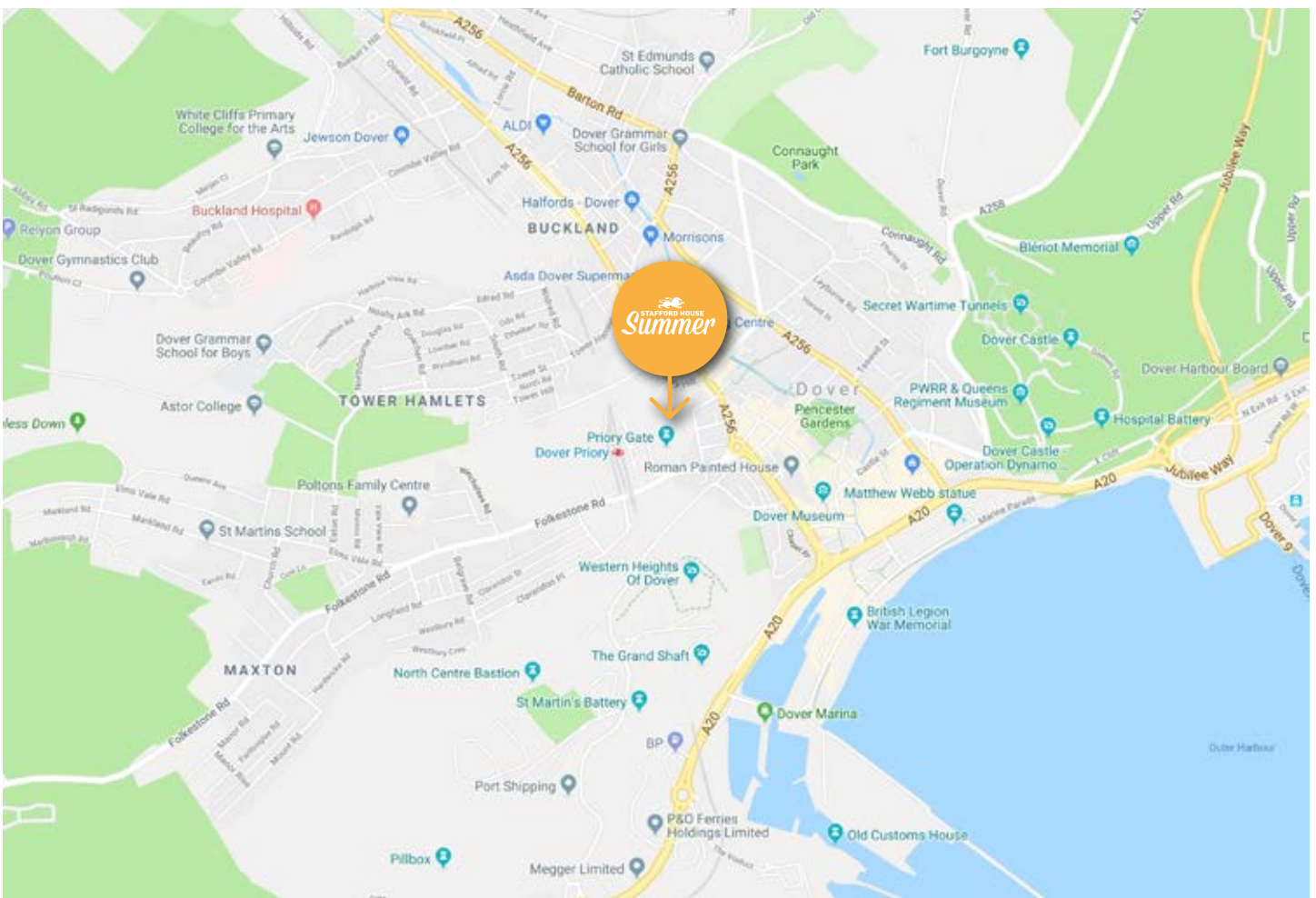
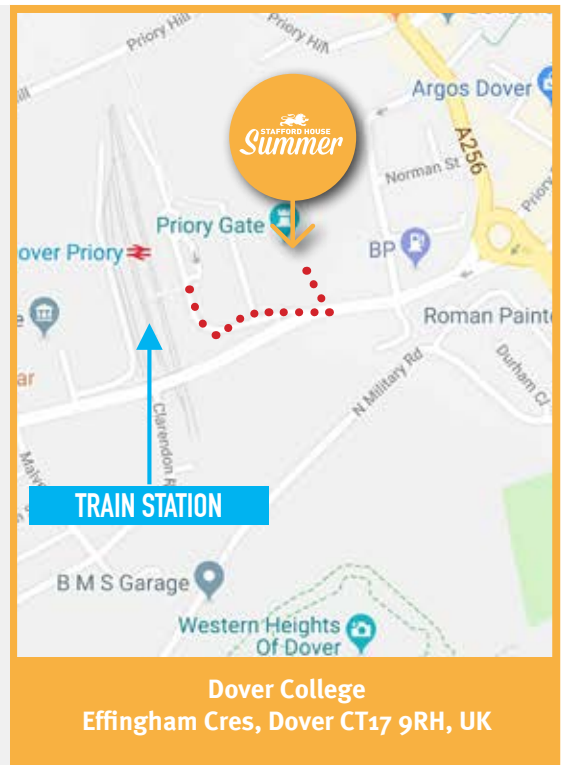
Direct from central London on the high speed train from London St Pancras to Dover Priory station, with a journey time of approximately one hour. Dover College is a two minute walk from the station. Eurostar trains stop at Ashford International Station, change here for trains to Dover Priory.

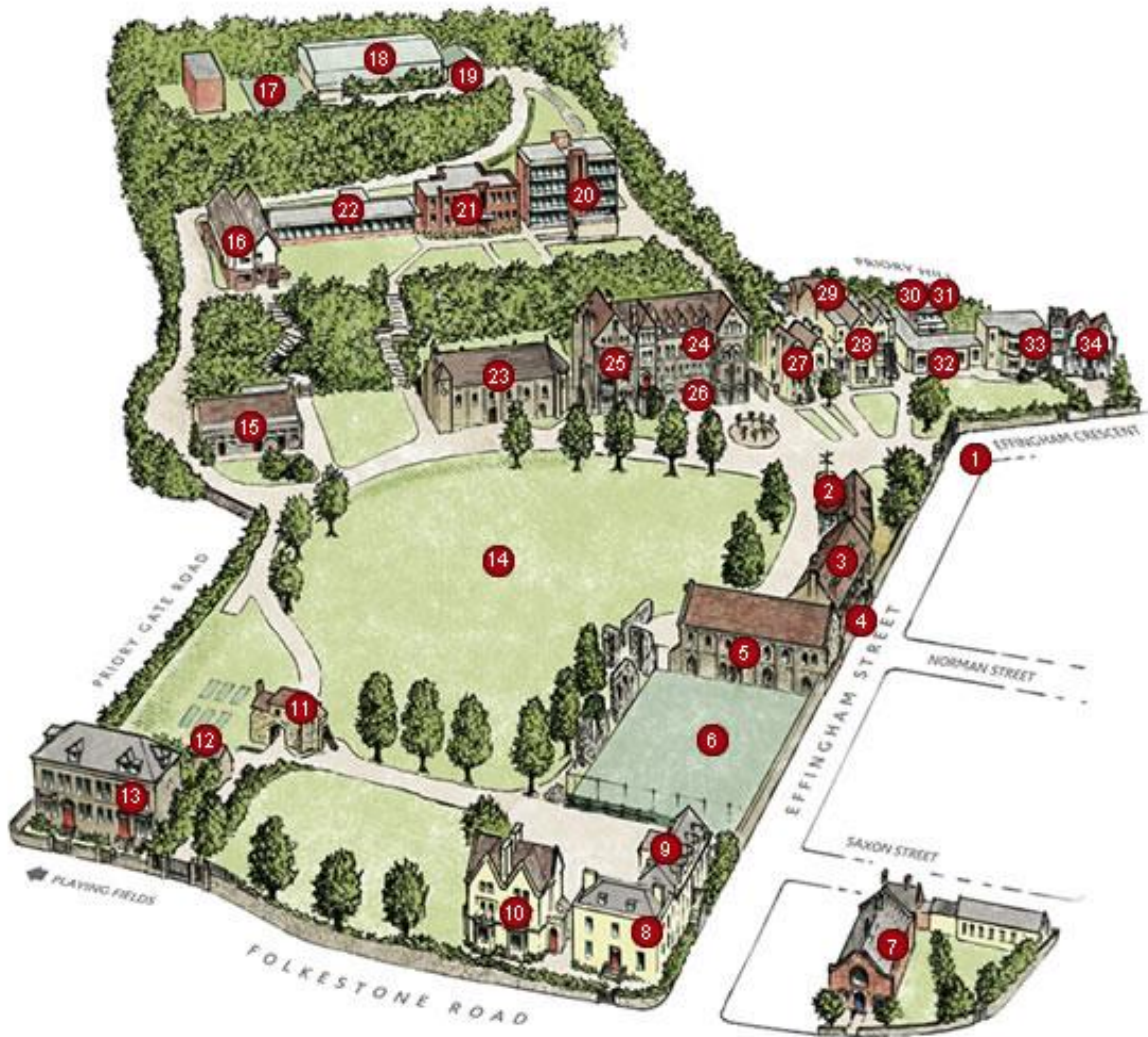


National Express Bus 021 leaves from London Victoria Coach Station and goes to Dover stopping at Pencester Road (Stop X). From there it is a 8min walk to the school



From London take A1203, A102 and A2 to M2 in Shorne. Continue on M2. Take M20 to Folkestone Rd/B2011. Take the exit for B2011 from A20. Follow Folkestone Rd/B2011 to Priory Station Approach Rd in Dover
