STUDENT WELFARE OFFICERS/TRANSFERS

SWOs and SWOTS are provided with the a company T-shirt(s) and a hoodie to be worn when on duty. You must also wear your provided lanyard at all times.

ACTIVITY LEADERS

Activity Leaders are provided with the a company T-shirt(s) and a hoodie to be worn when on duty. You must also wear your provided ID lanyard at all times.

You may wear tracksuit bottoms or shorts to the knees in hot weather or during activities.



TEACHERS

Teachers are provided with a company T-shirt for use on excursions, but this is not necessary for day-to-day teaching. You must dress in a smart-casual. You must also wear your provided ID lanyard at all times.
