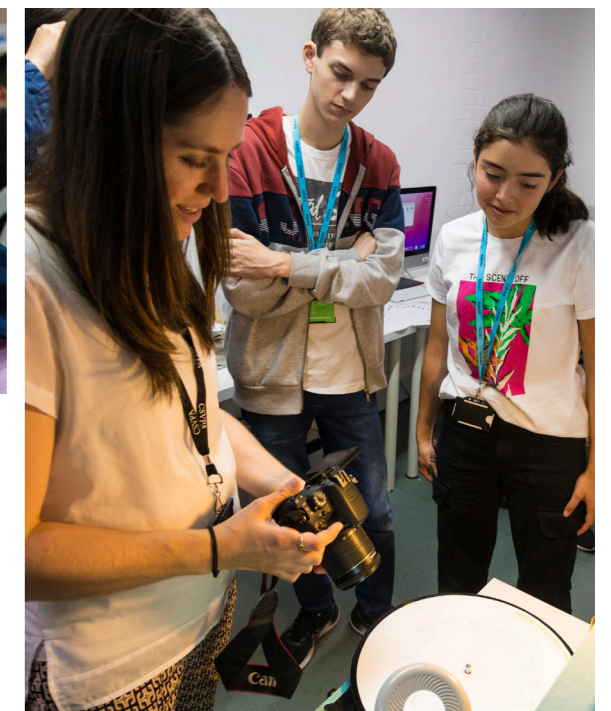


Film Making
