# **STAFF ACCOMMODATION FAQS**

## What does the accommodation include?

All residential roles include full room and board (breakfast, lunch and dinner) at our on-site canteens. Non-residential staff are also welcome to eat in our canteens, only when are working a shift.

#### What is the accommodation like?

Each centres accommodation will differ slightly. You can find out more about the accommodation on offer at your specific centre in our handy centre factsheets!

#### Do you cater to dietary requirements?

Most common dietary requirements are catered for at our canteens - it s best to let your centre team know when you arrive at the start of the summer if you have any more specific requirements, and we will do our best to cater for them.

#### When can I move into the accommodation?

You'll be asked to arrive at your centre on the morning of the first day of your contract (unless in a senior role).

If you are travelling a long way or from overseas, we may be able to provide your accommodation from the night before you are due to start - please contact us in advance to see if this is possible at your centre.

#### Will I stay in the same room during my contract?

Not necessarily. There may be some occasions when you are required to change rooms during the course of the summer. This could be for a variety of reasons, for example if we have a change in student numbers.

#### When will I need to move out of the accommodation?

The time you finish up on the last day of your contract will vary according to the needs of the centre, you'll be able to discuss this with your onsite team closer to the time.

## What do I need to bring with me?

We provide bed linen at all centres but you will need to bring your own towels with you. When packing, it's useful to remember that our dress code is smart/smart casual and that Activity/Welfare staff will be given a uniform (Company T- Shirt and/or Hoodie). Comfortable shoes, such as trainers are a must for everyone as you will be on your feet a lot!

# Is there any security for personal belongings?

We cannot take responsibility for your personal items and so generally recommend that you limit the number of valuable items you bring with you. These will need to be stored and looked after by yourself



The safeguarding of our students is always our priority, so unfortunately, we can't permit any visitors on site during your stay. Any visitors to site (e.g workshop facilitators) will be pre-appointed by Head Office.



Unfortunately all of our rooms are based on single occupancy only, so we aren't able to offer room sharing as an option.
