HOW YOU WILL LEARN

From the first day, students make progress in English by using the language in meaningful ways. New language is practised and mastered in the classroom, enabling students to communicate outside of school more confidently, accurately, and effectively. Our teachers act as coaches and facilitators, clarifying concepts, correcting errors in students' speaking and writing, and pushing everyone to participate to the maximum of their ability.

DEVELOP YOUR ENGLISH

In this module, you will focus on how to understand the meaning in reading texts by contextualising new vocabulary. Read fascinating articles and short stories, and discuss the issues and ideas that develop.



PRONUNCIATION MASTERCLASS | B2-C1

This class will focus on isolated sounds, connected speech, and a look at variation of accent and dialect. People will understand you more easily and you will understand other people's English faster.



IDIOMS & PHRASAL VERBS | B1-B2

Learn and practise the collocations and phrasal verbs that make speaking natural. Excellent for Cambridge students, or anyone who would like to speak more naturally.



ESSENTIAL GRAMMAR | A1-A2

A chance for low-level students to keep practising using the grammar they have been learning in class but don't feel confident with. This could include tenses, irregular verbs, sentence structure, articles... anything they like!







EXAM PREPARATION

HOW YOU WILL LEARN

These courses are a mixture of language input and exam strategies. The language input is aimed at broadening your vocabulary and grammatical range, while exam strategies help you become familiar with the many question types in your exam, and learn techniques to demonstrate to the examiner your knowledge of English. are also used for work and migration. You
cannot pass or fail an IELTS or TOEFL; rather
you get a score that tells you your level.

INVEST IN YOUR FUTURE

IELTS is now also the only test you can use to acquire a UK visa, when you apply from outside of the UK. Our IELTS preparation course prepares you for the IELTS Academic exam which is suitable for the UKVI application.

RECOGNISED WORLDWIDE

Both can be taken in over 130 countries around the world, and on almost every week of the year, and both will give you your results in about two weeks. IELTS is more well-known in the UK, Australia, New Zealand and Canada, whereas TOEFL is more well-known and widely accepted in the USA.

CAMBRIDGE EXAM PREPARATION

The Cambridge Suite of Exams, part of the University of Cambridge, are based on decades of unrivalled research in English Language learning, teaching and assessment. They are recognised globally by schools, universities and employers and never expire (so you don't have to take them again in two years' time).

Unlike IELTS and TOEFL, the Cambridge Suite exams are proficiency tests. This means that you must take the right test for your level. Because of this, the preparation you do for these exams really helps you improve your English, as it is aimed specifically at your level.

Stafford House is an approved testing centre for Cambridge Suite exams at all of our UK centres, as well as in our San Diego school. This means you can book and take your exams in the same place you have your lessons, which should reduce exam anxiety and help you perform better.

Stafford House offers preparation courses for the First, Advanced and Proficiency exams (formerly known as FCE, CAE and CPE). You can build a strong foundation with FCE and then progress through the suite to attain proficiency in English.

CAMBRIDGE ENGLISH FIRST / B2 FIRST

The Cambridge English First tests English at B2 level. This is the most popular exam in the Cambridge Suite, and it demonstrates that you can use everyday written and spoken English independently for work or study purposes.

CAMBRIDGE ENGLISH ADVANCED / C1 ADVANCED
