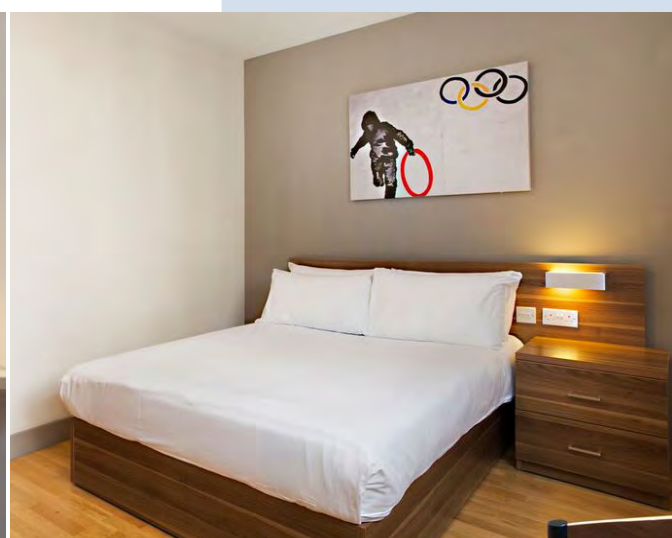


16/17 YEAR OLD SUMMER RESIDENCE (UK ONLY)

You can communicate effectively in most situations, discussing and expressing opinions on a wide range of topics. You will continue to broaden your vocabulary to become more fluent and accurate.

You can express yourself clearly and effectively. You have a sound grasp of major tenses and grammatical structures. You read widely and can follow the majority of what is said on TV, radio and film.

You can use a range of language close to that of your own language. You have no problem understanding or communicating. You now wish to extend your vocabulary and explore the nuances of idiomatic English.

MODULES

All students on our Standard, Intensive and Super Intensive courses can personalise their learning through the addition of specific modules. These modules run on four-week cycles and give students the ultimate flexibility, as modules are designed around what our students say they want and need.

Because they are designed to suit the specific needs of the students, modules vary from school to school, from month to month. Here are some examples of our most popular modules:

ACADEMIC & EXAM PREPARATION

ENGLISH FOR ACADEMIC PURPOSES | B2-C2

Gain tools necessary to succeed in an English-speaking academic environment. Learners will gain the needed skills in: listening to lectures, note taking, academic discussion, presentations and essay writing.

IELTS SKILLS: READING AND WRITING | B2-C1

For Intermediate + students who are on an IELTS path. An overview of the reading and writing components of the exam, the strategies needed for the question types and tasks, and a close look at vocab.

CAMBRIDGE CLINIC | B1-C1

Aimed at students studying for the Cambridge First, Advanced or Proficiency. This practical module is full of exam tips, practise tasks, vocab review and activation and will boost the skills of any Cambridge student.

GENERAL SKILLS DEVELOPMENT

SPEAKING FLUENCY | A1-C2

The purpose of this module is for students to develop their speaking skills for effective verbal communication in a variety of functional contexts such as socializing, complaining, apologizing, and persuading.

VOCAB THROUGH LISTENING | B2-C1

Listen to interesting texts on a range of relevant topics and extract useful or interesting language while engaging with the content. You can also make your own talks, presentations, sketches etc, to practise your new language.

PRONUNCIATION MASTERCLASS | B2-C1

This class will focus on isolated sounds, connected speech, and a look at variation of accent and dialect. People will understand you more easily and you will understand other people's English faster.

IDIOMS & PHRASAL VERBS | B1-B2

Learn and practise the collocations and phrasal verbs that make speaking natural. Excellent for Cambridge students, or anyone who would like to speak more naturally.

ESSENTIAL GRAMMAR | A1-A2

A chance for low-level students to keep practising using the grammar they have been learning in class but don't feel confident with. This could include tenses, irregular verbs, sentence structure, articles... anything they like! and make sure you are on track to reach your goals and fulfil your potential.

GRAMMAR CHALLENGE | B2-C1

For higher level students to practise using more complex grammatical structures and begin experimenting with different ways to express themselves.



CULTURE CLASS | B2-C1

A major goal of this course is to provide students with an effective means of using their environment as a learning tool, so they can benefit as fully as possible from the English present – be it the native language, the second language or a lingua franca.

PROFESSIONAL SKILLS

PRESENTATION SKILLS | B2-C2

Learn to create successful presentations and acquire confidence to speak in front of an audience. Everything from body language to intonation, this module will give students all the tools to become a master presenter.

SOCIAL MEDIA | B2-C2

Students will improve their social media skills to market themselves and their business. Students learn how to post on social media effectively and how to engage with their audience. Study how people use social media in their professional lives.

BUSINESS CULTURE | B2-C2

Explore corporate cultures and traditions within different nationalities. Focus on the diversity of business cultures and their connections to and comparison with other countries. Share your own experiences and learn from others.

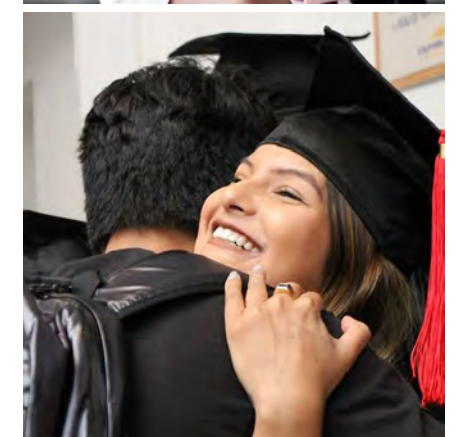

All our exam preparation courses cover the areas of your chosen exam in detail, ensuring you learn both the skills and the English language needed to achieve exam success, through the use of past papers and test taking strategies.

HOW YOU WILL LEARN

These courses are a mixture of language input and exam strategies. The language input is aimed at broadening your vocabulary and grammatical range, while exam strategies help you become familiar with the many question types in your exam, and learn techniques to demonstrate to the examiner your knowledge of English.

IELTS

The IELTS (the English Language Testing System) is designed to test the English level of students wishing to study at an English speaking college or university and is also used for work and migration. You cannot pass or fail an IELTS; rather you get a score that tells you your level.

RECOGNISED WORLDWIDE

IELTS can be taken in over 140 countries around the world, and on almost every week of the year, and will give you your results in about two weeks. IELTS is more well-known in the UK, Australia, New Zealand and Canada.

IELTS is now also the only test you can use to acquire a UK visa, when you apply from outside of the UK. Our IELTS preparation course prepares you for the IELTS Academic exam which is suitable for the UKVI application.

The Cambridge Suite of Exams, part of the University of Cambridge, are based on decades of unrivalled research in English Language learning, teaching and assessment. They are recognised globally by schools, universities and employers and never expire (so you don't have to take them again in two years' time).

Unlike IELTS, the Cambridge Suite exams are proficiency tests. This means that you must take the right test for your level. Because of this, the preparation you do for these exams really helps you improve your English, as it is aimed specifically at your level.

Stafford House is an approved testing centre for Cambridge Suite exams at all of our UK centres. This means you can book and take your exams in the same place you have your lessons, which should reduce exam anxiety and help you perform better.

OUR GLOBAL COMMUNITY

Stafford House is proud to support organisations that help less privileged, marginalised and vulnerable people across our global community gain access to education.

We believe education is a right for all and currently support the inspiring work of United World Schools, by raising funds for the running of the Ngang Som Thom school in Cambodia. We also support the vital work done by RefuAid by providing English courses to refugees and asylum-seekers in the UK.

OUR WORK WITH UWS

Since partnering with UWS our staff and students have consistently exceeded raising the funds needed to cover the running costs of our sponsored school. We've sent employees from across our centres to visit the Ngang Som Thom school, where they helped to teach lessons, got to know the students, and learnt all about the important work UWS

undertakes in a country where many children are beyond the reach of the education system. This year we are sending another team of employees to Cambodia to teach the students, aid the teachers and learn just how valuable education is for all peoples across the globe.

REFUAID

In our London school we have partnered with RefuAid by providing English scholarships for refugees who find themselves in need. So far in our collaboration we have helped inspirational individuals from Syria, Sudan, Darfur and other countries they have been forced to flee, and those students have gone on to BA or MA programmes at UK Universities. It's a partnership that enriches the life of the school, and we are very proud to be able to provide this support to these incredible individuals. By supporting displaced peoples in this way, we not only give them help with their education but also welcome them into our country and into our school communities.
