



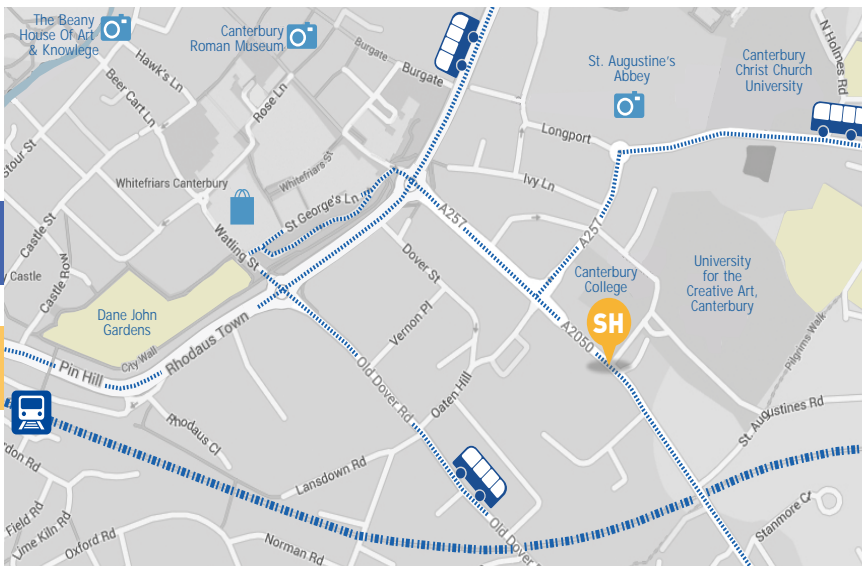
STAFFORD HOUSE CANTERBURY
