Tuition

We offer a variety of onsite activities including sports, arts and crafts and team games. Our activities provide opportunities for students to use the English they have learnt and make international friends.



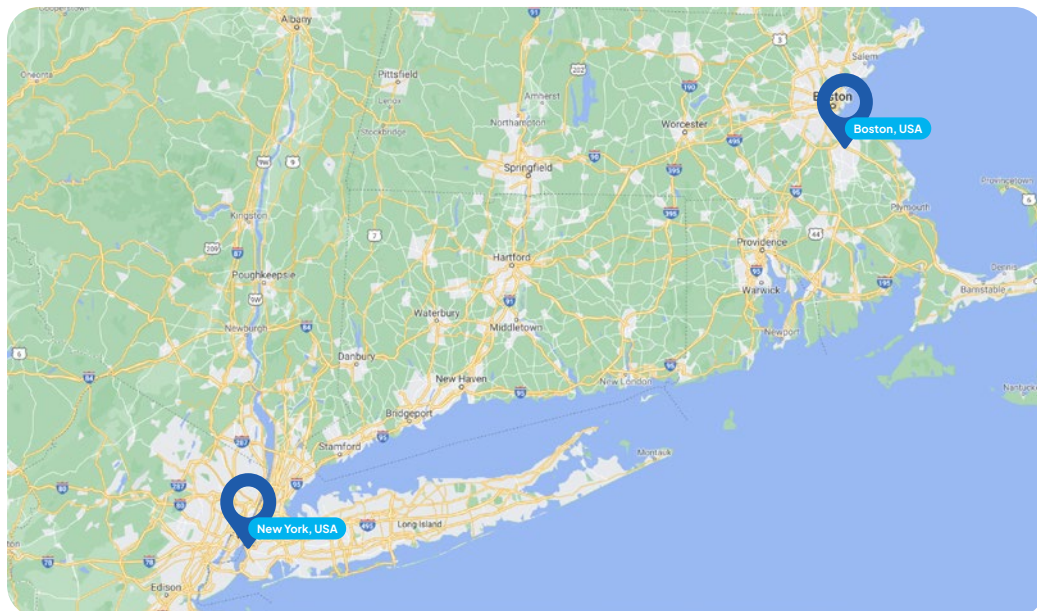
Excursions

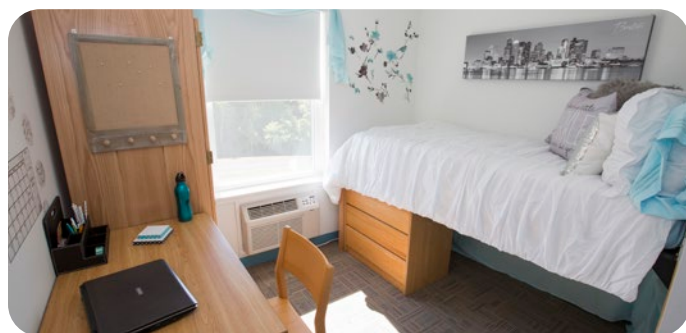
Certificate

Each student will have their English level tested upon arrival and will be placed in a class accordingly. Students will receive a portfolio to store their work in as well as a certificate to take home with them as a record of their course with us.

Excursions

One full-day and five half-day excursions per week are included in each city. In Boston, destinations may include the North End, Faneuil Hall and the Freedom Trail, a whale watching cruise, MIT and Harvard in Cambridge, the Isabella Stewart Gardner Museum, Fenway Park, Copley Square, Newbury Street, Back Bay and Canobie Lake Park. In New York, destinations may include the Statue of Liberty and Ellis Island, Wall Street and the 9/11 Memorial, Little Italy, Chinatown and Union Square, Times Square, the Empire State Building, Grand Central Station and Broadway, the High Line, Little Island, Hudson Yards, Central Park and the Metropolitan Museum.

Accommodation

In New York, residential accommodation onsite offering mini apartments featuring two twin rooms. Each mini apartment has 1 bathroom for a ratio of 4 students per bathroom.

In Boston, residential accommodation onsite in modern and airconditioned single en-suite bedrooms.

There are common rooms and modern study facilities, as well as WiFi available in all buildings. Laundry facilities are available in both locations.
