We offer a variety of activities including sports, arts and crafts and workshops. Our activities provide opportunities for students to use the English they have learnt in the classroom with their friends.



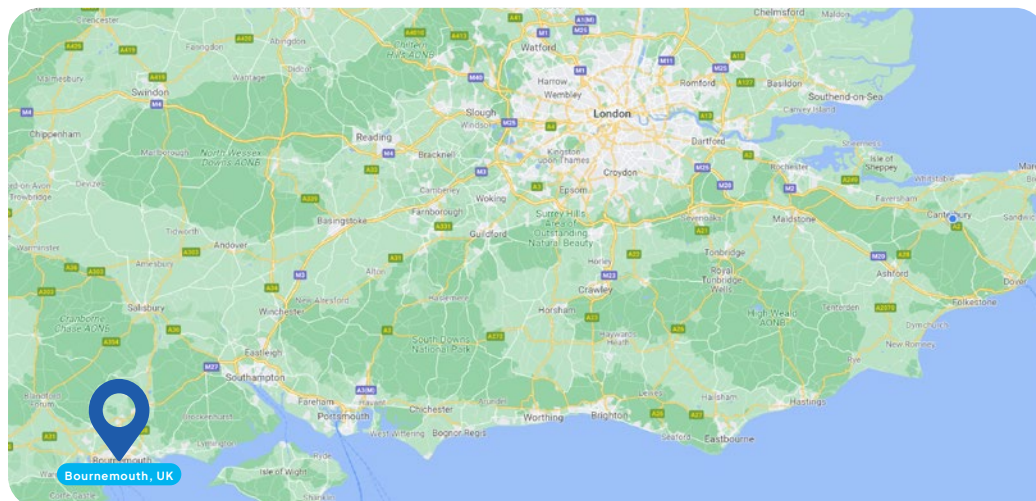
Excursions

Full and half day excursions, as well as local visits allow students to really get to know the UK. Students can explore the delightful city of Bournemouth on sightseeing tours. Destinations such as London become a classroom, where students will find historic and cultural information through guided walking tours.



Certificate

Each student will have their English level tested upon arrival and will be placed in a class accordingly. Students will receive a portfolio to store their work in as well as a certificate to take home with them as a record of their course with us.



Public Transport Information:

- Nearest airport: Gatwick 155km, Stansted 240km, Heathrow 155km
- Nearest rail station: Pokesdown Station 1.1km (13 min walk)
- High Speed train to London takes 1 hour and 50 minutes
- 10-minute walk from school to Boscombe Beach



Excursions

One full-day excursion per week is included. Destinations may include London, Oxford or Bath. Two half-day excursions per week are included, destinations may include Winchester, Stonehenge or Salisbury. Optional Excursions can be booked to destinations such as Windsor Castle or Brighton.

Accommodation

Two types of residential accommodation are available. Our standard accommodation is located on the school campus and is made up of shared rooms with shared bathrooms. Our Premium single ensuite rooms in our Cranbourne House residence are a short shuttle bus ride from the college, with buses running each morning and evening. All students have meals in the school canteen and they are given packed lunches on excursions.
