Overview

Perfect for seaside seekers and history hunters, Canterbury is a bustling cathedral city originally built by the Romans. Fun to explore and easy to walk around, Canterbury is a safe and comfortable place for all. Close to the beaches of the south coast and within easy reach of London, it is a great base to discover England.

The city centre is within walking distance from the school and offers an abundance of shops, restaurants and cafés ranging from high street favourites to independent stores. Classes take place at Stafford House Canterbury, Worthgate School Canterbury and Canterbury College.

The School

Our Canterbury camp is located just moments from the centre of the medieval city and is perfect for those looking for that classic English adventure. The school is well equipped with interactive whiteboards, a library and self-study room as well as a student lounge and courtyard. Homestay and residential accommodation are available as well as a shuttle bus to and from school each day. Some homestay placements are made by a third party accommodation provider.



Excursions

One full-day excursion per week is included. Destinations may include London, Brighton or Cambridge. One half-day excursion per week is included, destinations may include Leeds Castle, Dover Castle or Chatham. Optional Excursions can be booked to destinations such as Oxford, Windsor Castle or Thorpe Park.



Accommodation

Full-board Residential and Homestay** (minimum age 12) options. Homestay accommodation is in shared rooms. Residential rooms have 1–4 beds, all with private bathrooms. All students have hot lunch and hot dinner in the school canteen Mon–Fri.

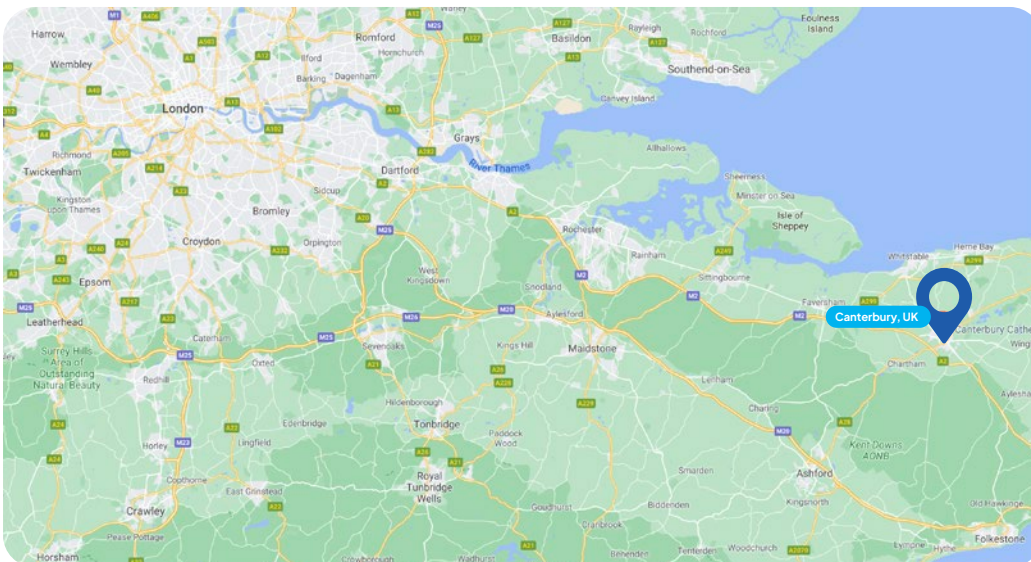
Tuition

Students will take part in 15 or 23 (Intensive course) hours of English language lessons per week. Lessons are topic based and designed to be fun, energetic and informative. They enable students to use their English in real world situations and increase their confidence.



Activities

We offer a variety of onsite activities including sports, arts and crafts and team games. Our activities provide opportunities for students to use the English they have learnt and make international friends.



Excursions

Full and half day excursions allow students to really get to know the UK. We use major destinations such as London, Cambridge and Brighton as a classroom where students will find historic and cultural information through guided walking tours and visits to museums and other places of interest.



Certificate

Each student will have their English level tested upon arrival and will be placed in a class accordingly. Students will receive a portfolio to store their work in as well as a certificate to take home with them as a record of their course with us.
