Tuition

22.5 hours per week of IELTS tuition with qualified and experienced teachers. Interactive classes which cover all four language skills: speaking, listening, reading and writing.

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Course Overview

Participants will take part in interactive classes which cover the four main skills: speaking, listening, reading and writing. Sessions will involve group activities, games and multi-media resources to keep students motivated and engaged. There will also be focus on essential vocabulary and grammar required. Exam strategies and practice tests as well as personalised feedback will be an essential part of the course - providing students with the tools for IELTS success.
