Tuition

Students will take part in 15 hours of English language lessons per week. Lessons are topic based and designed to be fun, energetic and informative. They enable students to use their English in real world situations and increase their confidence.

We offer a variety of onsite activities including sports, arts and crafts and team games. Our activities provide opportunities for students to use the English they have learnt and make international friends.



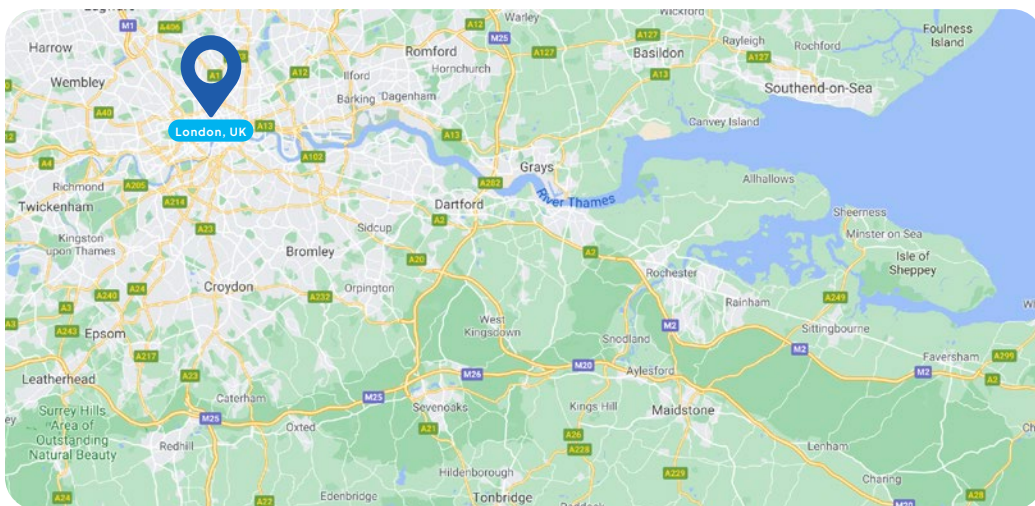
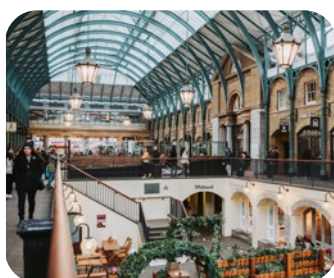
Excursions

Full and half day excursions allow students to really get to know the UK. We use major destinations such as London, Cambridge and Brighton as a classroom where students will find historic and cultural information through guided walking tours and visits to museums and other places of interest.



Certificate

Each student will have their English level tested upon arrival and will be placed in a class accordingly. Students will receive a portfolio to store their work in as well as a certificate to take home with them as a record of their course with us.

Excursions

One full-day excursion per week is included. Destinations may include Cambridge, Brighton or Canterbury. Five half-day sightseeing tours around London are also included per week. Optional Excursions can be booked to destinations such as Oxford, Windsor Castle or Thorpe Park.

Accommodation

Excellent en-suite accommodation is offered in two locations: Premier House (single and twin en-suite) a few steps away from the school, and Hayloft Point (single en-suite rooms) at Aldgate in the City of London. It is 5 underground stops away from the school, near Liverpool Street Station and Spitalfields Market. Both options are modern and well equipped, with stylish communal areas for socialising and relaxing.
