Classic Course

Brunel University occupies a modern and spacious campus, 15 minutes' walk from the lively town of Uxbridge, West London. The campus has some of the finest sports facilities in the country – which often host world-class athletes, including the British, US and Jamaican athletics teams. All classrooms, leisure facilities and accommodation are of a very high standard. As well as a range of on-campus amenities, students benefit from their proximity to Central London, with all the major attractions being easily accessible by tube.

Overview

Uxbridge is a suburban town in west London. The town centre is easily accessed from Brunel University either by walking, or a short bus ride. In the town our students can enjoy a coffee in Starbucks or a spot of shopping – there are many major high street stores, including an expansive Primark. Uxbridge has an underground train station with links directly into central London (approx. 1 hour). Its proximity to London means students can enjoy visits into London on half-day coach excursions.

We offer a variety of onsite activities including sports, arts and crafts and team games. Our activities provide opportunities for students to use the English they have learnt and make international friends.



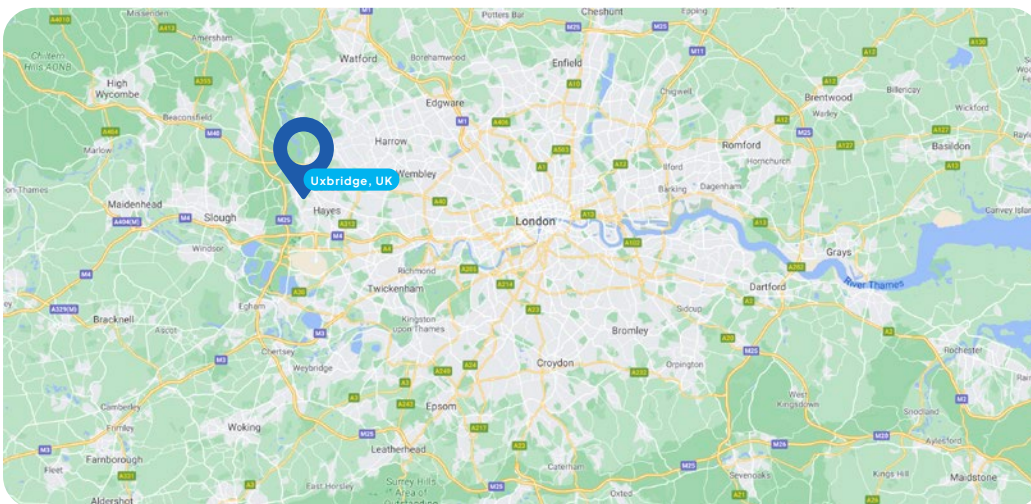
Excursions

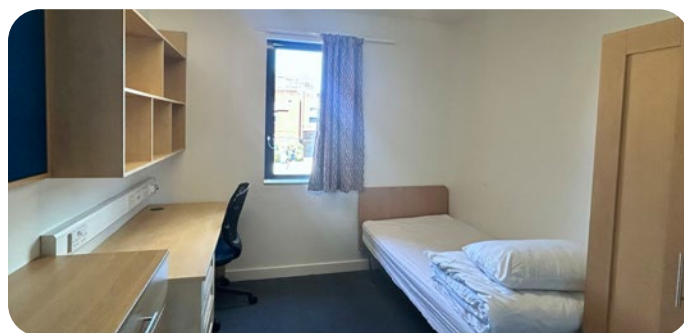
Certificate

Each student will have their English level tested upon arrival and will be placed in a class accordingly. Students will receive a portfolio to store their work in as well as a certificate to take home with them as a record of their course with us.

Excursions

One full-day excursion per week is included. Destinations may include London sightseeing, Brighton or Cambridge. Two half-day excursions per week are included, destinations may include the Natural History Museum, Science Museum or Oxford. Optional Excursions can be booked to destinations such as Canterbury, Bath or Thorpe Park.

Accommodation

Residential accommodation onsite, with single en-suite rooms furnished to a high standard. Coin-operated laundry facilities are available. Sports facilities include two large sports halls, sports fields and tennis courts. WiFi is available onsite.
