Wagner College in Staten Island features breathtaking views that overlook New York Harbor, Manhattan, Brooklyn and the Atlantic Ocean. Manhattan is a short ride away on the free Staten Island Ferry, giving students the chance to explore all New York City has to offer. On campus students will enjoy sports facilities including tennis courts, a sports hall and fields.

Overview

New York City is one of the most vibrant and exciting cities in the world, and our students will get the opportunity to explore the rich diversity of museums, cultures, arts, and attractions throughout the boroughs. From campus, a free shuttle takes you to the world-famous Staten Island ferry, a well-recognised icon of New York City transportation and a free ride into the heart of New York City.

As well as the world famous Manhattan there are four other boroughs in New York City - The Bronx, Queens, Brooklyn and Staten Island - and they help to form the richness and diversity of the City. Students will get to explore sites throughout the entirety of the city and get a real feel for life in the Big Apple.

The School

The lush Wagner College campus is located in Staten Island, where students can enjoy stunning views of Manhattan's skyline. From the campus a free 20-minute Ferry ride will take students to the heart of Wall Street. The campus features a state-of-the-art computer lab, a Starbucks coffee bar, a modern cafeteria and a beautiful library. Sports facilities include tennis courts and fields and are available at set times.

Excursions

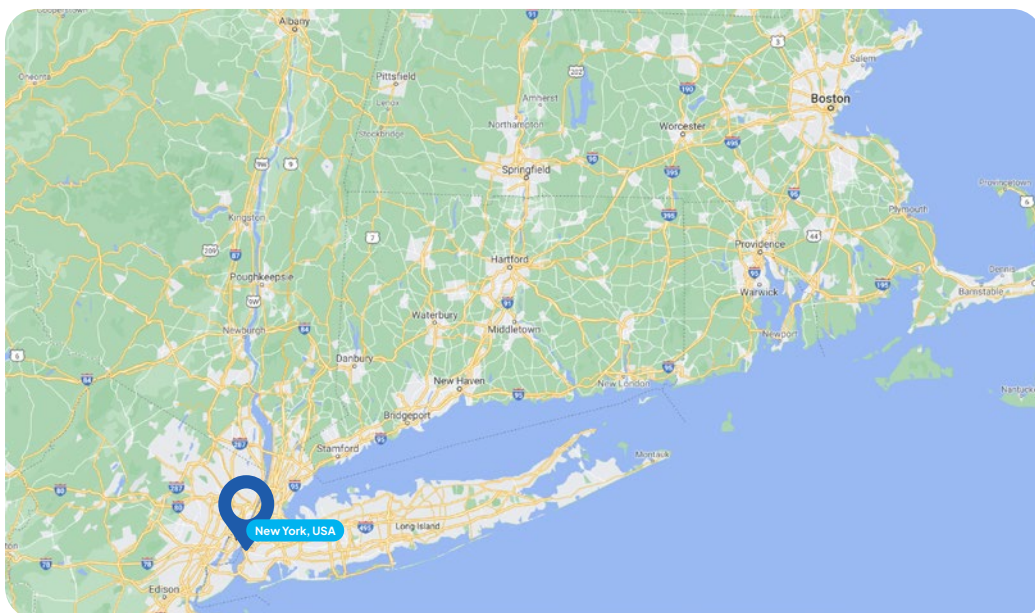

Afternoon excursions extend into the evening. Groups remain in Manhattan for dinner before returning to campus, allowing students to experience New York in a more immersive manner.



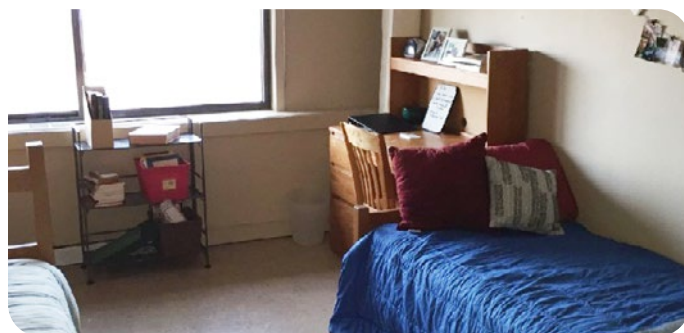
Certificate

Each student will have their English level tested upon arrival and will be placed in a class accordingly. Students will receive a portfolio to store their work in as well as a certificate to take home with them as a record of their course with us.

Excursions

One full-day and five half-day excursions per week are included. Destinations may include the Rockefeller Center, St Patrick Cathedral, City Hall, Brooklyn Bridge Park and Promenade, Battery Park, Wall Street (Memorial & Museum), Central Park & Top of The Rock, Union Square, East Village, Little Italy, Chinatown, Empire State Building, Grand Central Station, Times Square & Broadway, Staten Island Mall, MoMa and Harlem.

Accommodation

Residential accommodation onsite offering mini apartments featuring two twin rooms. Each mini apartment has 1 bathroom for a ratio of 4 students per bathroom. There are common rooms and modern study facilities, as well as WiFi available in all buildings. Coin-operated laundry facilities are available.
