Tuition

Students studying IELTS or STEM will take part in 22.5 hours of lessons per week. Those on the classic course will take part in 15 hours of lessons. We offer a variety of activities including sports, arts and crafts and workshops. Our activities provide opportunities for students to use the English they have learnt in the classroom with their friends.



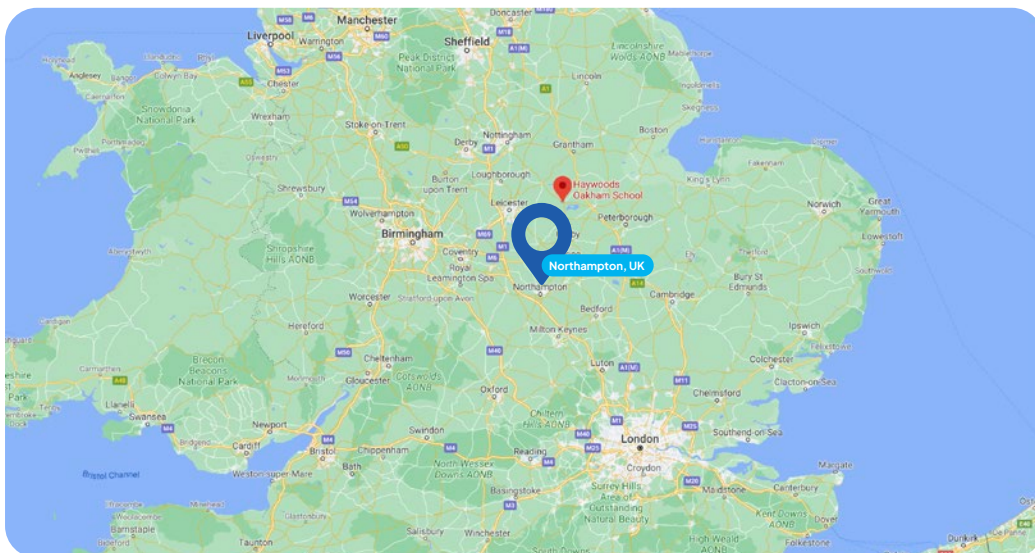
Excursions

Certificate

Each student will have their English level tested upon arrival and will be placed in a class accordingly. Students will receive a portfolio to store their work in as well as a certificate to take home with them as a record of their course with us.
