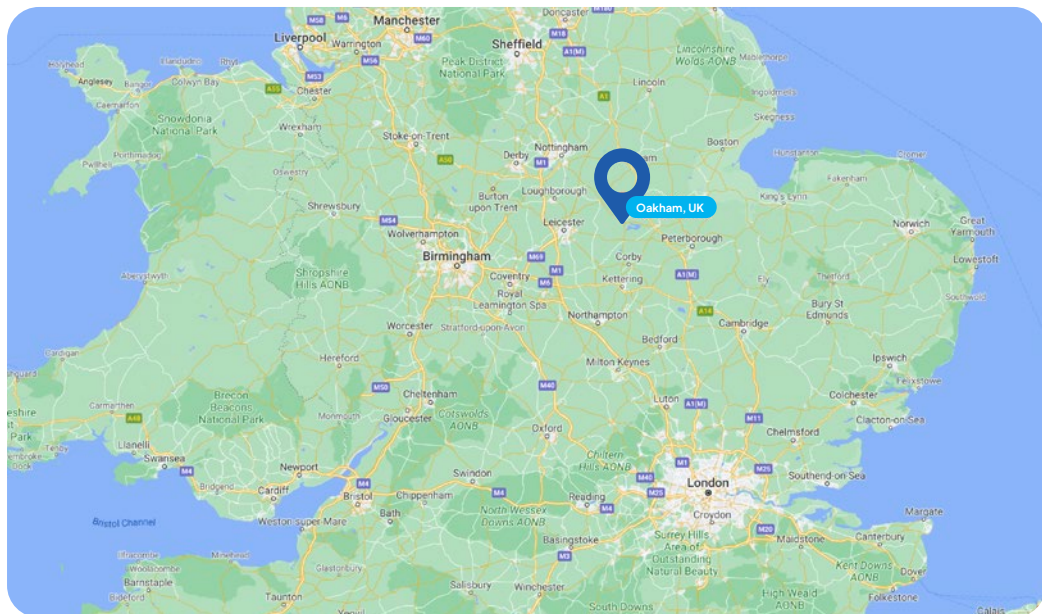
Tuition

Students will take part in 15 hours of English language lessons per week. Lessons are topic based and designed to be fun, energetic and informative. They enable students to use their English in real world situations and increase their confidence.



Activities

We offer a variety of onsite activities including sports, arts and crafts and team games. Our activities provide opportunities for students to use the English they have learnt and make international friends.



Excursions

Full and half day excursions allow students to really get to know the UK. We use major destinations such as London, Cambridge and Warwick as a classroom where students will find historic and cultural information through guided walking tours and visits to museums and other places of interest.



Certificate

Each student will have their English level tested upon arrival and will be placed in a class accordingly. Students will receive a portfolio to store their work in as well as a certificate to take home with them as a record of their course with us.

Excursions

One full-day excursion per week is included. Destinations may include London, Cambridge or Warwick Castle. Two half-day excursions per week are included, destinations may include Stamford, Rutland Water, Wollaton Hall or Peterborough. Optional Excursions can be booked to destinations such as Oxford, Birmingham or Alton Towers.

Accommodation

Residential accommodation is onsite, in small boarding houses. Most rooms are singles, twins or small dormitories with shared bathroom facilities. Most houses have their own individual common room; others have use of a shared room with television, as well as laundry facilities and WiFi. Sports facilities onsite include an indoor swimming pool, sports hall, tennis courts and sports fields.
