Booking Facts

The course price includes:

How to Book

After selecting your centre(s), please contact us to request a provisional booking ('Option'), detailing numbers of students, age range, preferred dates and duration of stay. It is vital that you specify which course or courses you wish to request a provisional booking for. We will add your booking to our reservations database system. We will then send you a Reservation Form, which outlines our payment schedule.

For summer groups, the standard payment schedule is as follows:

- Deposit, amounting to 10% of the total course fees (non-refundable), payable on 1st March. This will secure your booking.
- Instalment of 20% of the course fees, due on 1st May
- Balance of 70% of the course fees, payable at least one month before arrival

Some centres have different payment schedules which will be detailed in the reservation form.

A reservation fee of £200 is payable at the time of booking on all courses for Individuals to secure your place (for the US this is \$250). The reservation fee is non refundable.
