WHAT'S INCLUDED:



TUITION

Students will take part in 15 hours of English language lessons per week. Lessons are topic based and designed to be fun, energetic and informative. They enable students to use their English in real world situations and increase their confidence.



WATERSPORTS

Students will take part in 9 hours per week of watersports including a combination of wakeboarding (one-to-one coaching), stand-up paddleboarding (SUPing), kayaking and access to the exhilarating aqua park.



ACTIVITIES

We offer a variety of onsite activities including sports, arts and crafts and team games. The school day will finish with an evening activity which will include discos, international nights and talent shows. Our activities provide opportunities for students to use the English they have learnt and make international friends.



EXCURSIONS

Full and half day excursions allow students to really get to know the UK. We use major destinations such as London, Cambridge and Edinburgh as a classroom where students will find historic and cultural information through guided walking tours and visits to museums and other places of interest.



CERTIFICATE

Each student will have their English level tested upon arrival and will be placed in a class accordingly. Students will receive a portfolio to store their work in as well as a certificate to take home with them as a record of their course with us.

ENGLISH AND WATERSPORTS

BOURNEMOUTH, UK

Students receive 15 hours per week of English language tuition, plus 9 hours per week of watersports. New Forest Water Park is set in 50 acres of countryside and lakes with onsite changing rooms, toilet facilities and lockers.

COURSE STRUCTURE

Students will spend one of their visits at the exhilarating aqua park (the UK's largest outdoor inflatable floating sports waterpark!) featuring trampolines, monkey bars, flippers, slides, hurdles, springboard, rockers, rollers, an overhang climbing wall, swings and much more. Four more visits (2 per week) to the Water Park will consist of a combination of exciting watersports including wakeboarding, stand up paddleboarding and kayaking. When wakeboarding students will experience the 150m straight line cable (system 2.0) under the constant control and instruction from a coach. Kayaking and stand up paddleboarding (SUPing) will give students the opportunity to explore the tranquil freshwater lake. All equipment and safety aids are provided and students must be able to swim 50 metres.

Minimum 6 students required to run this course (each week)

ENGLISH, ACTIVITIES & EXCURSIONS

As well as a focus on their chosen plus course, students will be able to enjoy our classic programme of English lessons, activities and excursions. Each student will take part in specially designed English lessons which are fun, interactive and topic based. They will equip students with the confidence to take part in a full programme of activities and excursions. Our excursion programme includes one full-day and two-half day excursions per week to destinations of cultural and historic interest. Each day will end with an energetic evening activity which encourages students to socialise with their new international friends. Evening activities are varied and fun and may include discos, talent shows and international evenings
