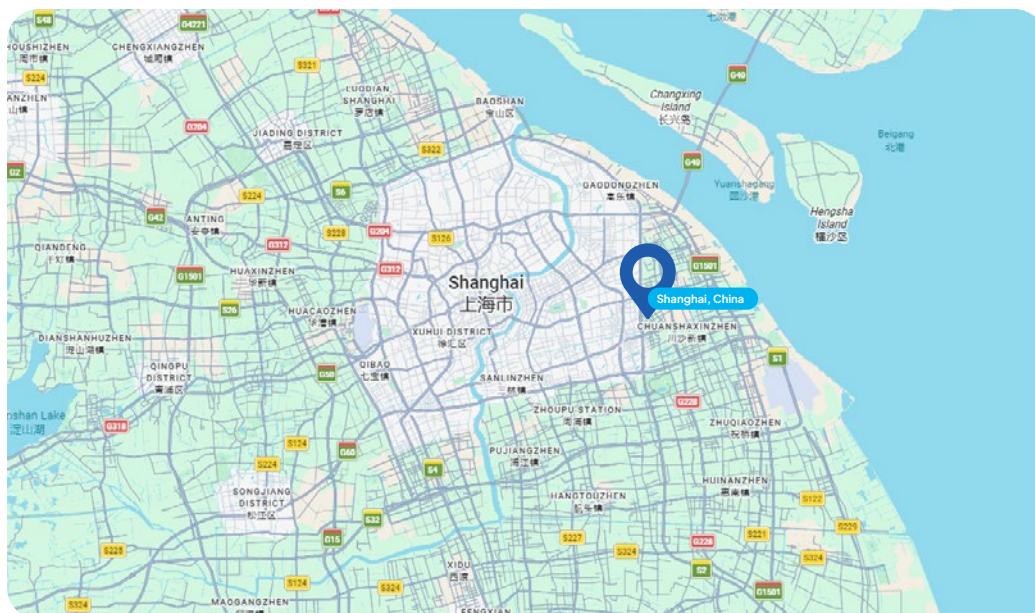

Tuition

Students will take part in 11 hours of lessons per week. Lessons are topic based and designed to be fun, energetic and informative, with 15 to 20 students per class. They enable students to use their English in real world situations and increase their confidence.



Activities

We offer a variety of onsite activities including sports, arts and crafts and team games. Our activities provide opportunities for students to use the English they have learnt and make international friends.



Excursions

Full and half day excursions allow students to really get to know the area. We use popular destinations as a classroom where students will find historic and cultural information through guided walking tours and visits to various places of interest.



Certificate

Each student will have their English level tested upon arrival and will be placed in a class accordingly. Students will receive a certificate to take home with them as a record of their course with us.



Excursions

Multiple half-day and full-day excursions are included each week. Half-day excursions may include Zhujiajiao Ancient Water Town, Paradise of Anime and Games, and the former French Concession on Huaihai Road. Full-day excursions may include the British Prime Minister's route in Shanghai (The Bund and Yu Garden), Premium Outlets shopping, and Suzhou, known as the "Venice of China." Students may also choose to enjoy a relaxing weekend on campus or opt for a full-day trip to Disneyland or Legoland at an additional charge.

Accommodation

On-campus accommodation is available in twin rooms, each with a private bathroom. Common rooms, modern study facilities, and a laundry room are provided, with WiFi accessible in all buildings.
